
OBSERVE THESE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Though Our take the utmost care to produce safe sewing machines and devices, operators should follow these basic rules.

- To prevent accidents, do not remove safety devices or parts while operating the machine.
- Do not leave tools or other unnecessary objects on the machine table while operating the machine.
- Before maintenance, adjusting, cleaning, threading or replacing the needle, and to prevent accidents, be sure the power is turned off. Check that the machine will not operate when the pedal is pressed.


In case a clutch type motor is used, it will keep on rotating by inertia after turning off power supply. ①If the machine pedal ② is stepped on inadvertently, it is dangerous because the machine will move unexpectedly. Keep on stepping on the pedal ② until the machine comes to a stop after turning off power supply.



- Turn the power off before leaving the machine table.
- In the event of a power failure, be sure to turn the machine off.
- Check that the machine is securely groundee.

Cut the table referring to the diagram




BEFORE

Lubrication

After filling the oil pan, the oil surface should lie between (H) and (L) lines.


Add oil, when the oil surface reaches or goes below (L).

Manual lubrication


Apply 2 to 3 drops of oil by hand when the machine is used for the time or has been left unused for some time.



BEFORE OPERATING Filling the HR device with silicon oil


Fill the HR device with oil before it is too low in order to prevent needle thread breakage and fabric damage.

Note: Use Pegasus recommended silicone oil. (UNION CARBIDE CORPORATION) UCCL-45(350)


Threading



TEST SEWING


Presser foot pressure

Loosen the adjusting nut 1 and turn the adjusting nut 2 to adjust the presser foot pressure. It should be as light as possible, yet be sufficient to obtain proper stitch formation.



Diff. feed ratio adjustment

Loosen the adjusting nut $\ \, \textcircled{1}\ \,$ and turn the adjusting nut $\ \, \textcircled{2}\ \,$ to adjust the differential feed ratio.




TEST SEWING Adjusting the top feed pressure

Note: This description is for reference only for M-1F models.

Loosen the adjusting nut $\ \, \textcircled{1}\ \,$ and turn the adjusting nut $\ \, \textcircled{2}\ \,$ to adjust the top feed pressure.


It should be as possible, yet be sufficient to obtain proper stitch formation.



TEST SEWING Adjusting the top feed front-to-back motion

Note:This description is for reference only for M-1F models.


After loosening the adjusting nut $\ \, \textcircled{1}$, turn the adjusting nut $\ \, \textcircled{2}$ to adjust the feed front-to-back motion.



TEST SEWING

Stitch length adjustment

While pressing the push button, turn the handwheel to seek the position at which the push button goes further into the depth. Then, handwheel and set the desired scale to the aligning mark.




TEST SEWING

Thread tension


Make tension adjustments with the needle thread knob ①, the upper looper knob

2 and the lower looper knob 3.



Cleaning the machine


Mainly the slots of the needle plate and the feed rows should be cleaned.




Replacing the needle

Check the needle carefully to see that the scarf is turned to the rear of the machine.

Insert the needle to the proper depth, and fasten securely.




Checking the oil circulation




Checking and replacing the oil filter

Check and replace the oil filter every six months.




Replacing the oil

Replace the oil one month after the first use and every six months there after. (See p 2.)





Replacing the lower knife
