### We won IPR infringement case of button sewing machine in China

We have filed a civil suit against Japsew Corporation that has manufactured sewing machine J-377 that infringed our patent and design rights in the JUKI button sewing machines MB-1370 series and that sold them under the JAPSEW brand. The Shanghai No. 1 Intermediate People's Court handed down a decision to order Japsew Corporation to compensate us for the damages and prohibit the sales on December 17, 2010. Finally, our winning the case was fixed.

To supply the products that can satisfy the customers in response to their trust, we continue the protecting activity of (IPRs) intellectual property rights (patent, design, and trademark). Moreover, we focus on shaping the culture of esteeming intellectual property rights in Chinese market by taking a strict action to protect our rights from any future violation of them.
